**Shipping** is one of the world's most polluting, yet unregulated industries. All over the world, vessels often burn heavy fuel oil (HFO) - the dirtiest of all fuels - but it is in the Arctic that the use of HFO is a particularly dangerous business.

**Sea Blind** is a powerful and convincing illustration of what increased shipping could mean for both the Arctic ecosystem and climate change, and looks at what the potential alternatives to HFO use in the Arctic might entail.

Following the screening, there will be an opportunity for discussion with Clean Arctic Alliance members and the film maker and you can hear more about the **Arctic Commitment**, an initiative calling on businesses and organisations to call for a phase-out of heavy fuel oil from Arctic shipping.
